

## SEDEF APARTMENTS

The composition of this project for a twelve-storey residential tower that overlooks Bagdat Caddesi, one of the main shopping streets of Istanbul, is generated from a not designed given starting point: two-flats and four-flats plans alternating every two floors. To counterbalance the uniformity given by the repetition of identical windows on each floor, such as the lodges in front of the kitchens and the toilet windows, we used few items.

All elements introduced serve to avoid the extreme symmetry and follow a simple logic: fully glazed terraces on apartments on west and south facades to enjoy the best views, floor to ceiling windows to slenderize the proportions of the building, solid balconies in front of the bedrooms to maintain a certain level of privacy. The dark basaltic stone cladding is a rather massive and solid element, which gives a uniform and elegant character to the tower and stands as contrasting but complementary component of a building that that opens itself to the city.
